Now able to accommodate over 4,000 bottles, the hand-built redwood racking systems together with sophisticated temperature and humidity controls, enable us to store wine in absolutely perfect conditions. The cellar is adjacent to the Victorian kitchen garden and its bespoke lighting and fully glazed entrance door allow guests to discover its uniqueness at any time. The cellar showcases a recently acquired 300-bottle collection of Burgundy wines that include no less than 11 vintages of Domaine Ramonet Montrachet Grand Cru as well as a fine selection of some of the best names and vintages from Bordeaux. Fully functioning as our working cellar, the space is also used for wine tastings, tutorials and bespoke receptions.

This wine list is a work in progress featuring just over 550 bins. We endeavour to search out some of the more interesting, drinkable and good value wines from around the world and our collection ranges from the famous to the classic, from local to New World and alongside these, there are samples of both organic and biodynamic wines. Thanks to an ever expanding selection of both wines by the glass and half bottles, we also offer guests a very affordable experience.

With his extensive knowledge of wine gained over many years of experience, Managing Director, Pedro Bento and his highly trained team of Sommeliers work tirelessly on this collection. They are always on hand to guide and help guests make the perfect choice whilst fully understanding that everyone has their own personal tastes and preferences.

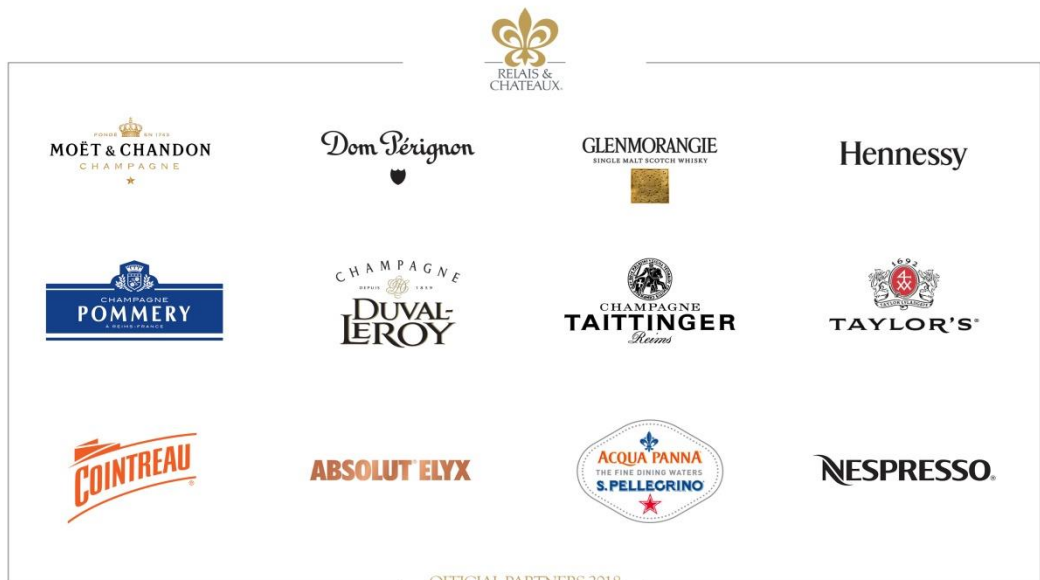

## **BIODYNAMIC AND ORGANIC WINES**

To help understand the difference between the two, here is a short explanation:

### ***Biodynamic grapes***

We're not sure exactly how and why biodynamics work so well, but when combined with great winemaking, the results can be sublime. After all, the most expensive wine in the world, Romanée-Conti, is biodynamic!

Biodynamic viticulture is a stage further than organic. It is natural, not only because no chemicals are used, but it also takes into account the forces of nature - the seasons, the phases of the moon and planetary constellations. Just as the moon gives us the tides, the moon can influence moisture content in the vine and the soil, creating a biodynamic calendar, which gives the best times to plant, prune and prepare the soil.

It seems that vine growers are reconnecting with the soil and with nature just as they used to thousands of years ago.

In summary, biodynamic viticulture is an holistic approach whose main aim is to nurture the soil and the life within it. By increasing the humus content and microbial life of the soil, the vines roots will get the nourishment they need, above ground the vine will be healthier and the yeasts that grow on the grape skins will reflect the true character of the vineyard site. This result in wines that have more individuality, some would also say purity of flavour and balance.

Vineyard treatments, ploughing, pruning etc are carried out according to nature's calendar. Gravitational forces, such as the pull of the moon and where the earth is in relation to the sun and other planets, can have an effect on the vine's sap and some say it is like the earth is breathing in and out. Farming in accordance with the planets is not a new theory! It is only in the last few decades that mechanisation and technology have started to replace the age-old knowledge. You don't have to be biodynamic to make good wine, but biodynamic will help to bring out the best, most authentic wine from a given site.

### ***Organic grapes***

When we talk about organic wine what we generally mean is wine made from organically grown grapes - from vineyards that have not been treated with man-made chemical fertilisers, weedicides and pesticides that can enter the vine's sap and the grape pulp. Instead, organic growers use compost, cover crops and natural predators in a 'prevention is better than cure' approach.

Wines certified as organically grown have undergone a three-year conversion period. There are many different certifying bodies in each country and their criteria vary slightly.
